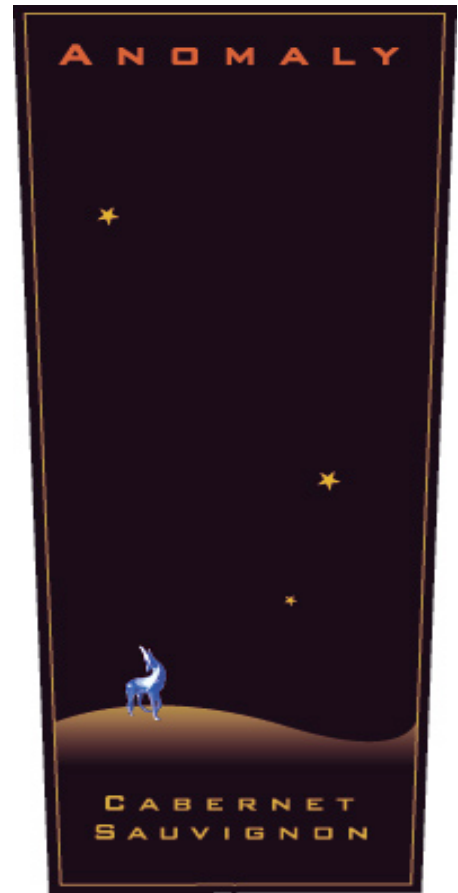


Anomaly Vineyards

2009 Cabernet Sauvignon

Anomaly Vineyards is located at the base of the Mayacamas Mountains just west of the town of St Helena in California's Napa Valley. From our 8 acres of vineyards planted to the Bordeaux varietals Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot, we specialize in the production of just one wine, the Anomaly Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon.

Owners Steve and Linda Goldfarb serve as stewards of the property, while relying on Winemaker Mark Porembski to frame the grace of the vineyard in each successive vintage. Although drinking beautifully now, the 2009 Anomaly will continue to evolve in the cellar and could be held to age for a decade or more.
